

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

The 2017 Annual Fall Conference of the Indiana Association of School Psychologists (IASP) will be held **September 20-22** in Muncie. We are issuing the call for presentations to provide programming that meets a variety of professional needs and interests. The conference will cover a broad array of professional topics while emphasizing evidence-based practices for improved student outcomes, enhanced professional best practices, meaningful collaborations at the state and local level, and implementing the NASP Model for Comprehensive and Integrated School Psychological Services. Proposals addressing topics such as intervention and instructional strategies, prevention and school-wide practices, graduate student and early career issues, and evaluating outcome and effectiveness are especially encouraged.

Professionals including practitioners, researchers, trainers, graduate students, administrators, counselors, and others who work with children and youth are encouraged to submit proposals. Members of IASP are encouraged to disseminate this call for presentations with professionals across disciplines to share interests, best practices, and ideas for serving children and youth in Indiana.

Presentations may consist of panel discussions, demonstrations, lectures, or an alternative format appropriate for sharing your ideas. A reduced conference registration rate will be offered to presenters. Audiovisual equipment must be requested in advance of the conference. At your request IASP will provide a screen. Laptop computers must be provided by the presenters. If you are chosen for a presentation, slides must be received September 1, 2017 to be included in the email to attendees. Hard copies of presentations will not be provided to attendees.

Proposals should consist of 1) a completed Conference Presentation Cover Sheet (attached) and 2) a three page or less summary identifying the title, purpose, overview, and learning outcomes of the proposed presentation. Both the Cover Sheet and the Summary should be submitted electronically to Jill Ewing at <u>jillewing@thecorydongroup.com</u> by **July 1**, **2017**. Please use the presentation title as the file name, not the presenter(s) name, for the Summary file. A blind review will be conducted and all proposals will be given serious consideration for acceptance. Decisions about selected proposals will be communicated by **July 28**, **2017**.
